## Pages of the Navigation layer

Home page	<ul> <li>→ Starting point of the navigation through the web site sections and related content/document types</li> <li>→ Space to highlight selected items</li> </ul>
Portal page	→ Cover of a section subdivide in sub-sections → Space to highlight selected items
<u>Catalogue</u> page	→ Section page listing a specific content/document type - Events, Projects, Publications etc.
Topic page	<ul> <li>→ Page describing the Topic (Theme, Country, ILO Unit)</li> <li>→ Lists of content/document types classified by that topic</li> <li>→ Space to highlight selected items</li> </ul>

## Pages of the Destination layer

<u>Destination</u> page	→ Page describing, displaying or downloading a content/document: Events, Projects, Publications etc.
<b>Editorial</b>	$\rightarrow$ Usually it contains a text for reading
<u>page</u>	→ It is accessible directly from the main navigation menu

Relationship link	<b>Navigation among related items</b> It is a link automatically generated by the Navigation interface once manually related two different documents in the CS	Manual building of lists	-
