APPLIS: new site index

- The general concept is to give two views or access points: one is by content type (Instruments, Ratifications, comments etc.), the other is by country. It is because not all the content types are strictly related to the supervision of country, for example "instruments" is something a part and also EW comments. Also the registration of comments is related to NORMES work and as such is not really information concerning the country, it has an effect on it but it is a separate operation.
- o There is also the idea to have a dedicated search per each content type, now search features are completely missing. The goal is allowing to users to view at the data in different ways, it can be used for reporting as well. Beside that it can become a tool to organize and keep under control the daily job.
- o Due to the above point, the system must be able to export data producing word or excel file from the lists in HTML on the screen.
- Note that the section "5.1 Comments by supervisory bodies", mainly used to register comments, is the one has an effect to the section "4.1 Reports on Art 22 and 35" and consequently to section "4.4. Reporting schedule (Art. 22 and 35)". Both are automatically updated by any change of comment (new insertion, deletion or change of comment type).
- The section "5.1 Comments by supervisory bodies" contains now any type of comment is published into the CEACR report. This section must be used to create the index of the publication produced by TRAITEXT. The goal is to have a unique place to refer to for NORMES and TRAITEXT during the process of producing the CEACR report. This is one of the biggest improvements, and it is also probable that we need to re-examine the way NORMES and TRAITEXT collaborate together.


Ratifications registration




Registration of submissions to competent authorities
